Free transport for getting to vaccination and screening appointments.

We want to make sure that routine health care is as easy to access as possible for Derbyshire residents.

That's why we're running a new scheme until March 31st 2023 offering free transport to a variety of routine health appointments including vaccination appointments and some screening programmes.

The support will cover a pre-paid taxi journey to and from your health appointment.

The free transport offer will cover the following health appointments:

The following vaccination appointments - Covid-19 / Flu / Shingles and other NHS provided vaccinations

Abdominal aortic aneurysm (AAA) screening

Cervical cancer screening

Bowel cancer screening

Diabetic Eye Screening

You need to be a Derbyshire resident to qualify for the free transport offer. It's open to all ages and is not means tested so you do not need to be receiving benefits to be eligible.
